Dear Senator Begich:

On behalf of the four million members of the Alliance for Retired Americans, we write in support of your legislation, the Protecting and Preserving Social Security Act, S. 308. This legislation is vital for older Americans to ensure a dignified quality of life in retirement as well as to keep the promise of a sustainable Social Security system.

Your legislation makes several essential changes to Social Security. First, it revises the cost of living adjustment (COLA) formula so that future COLAs will more accurately reflect the spending patterns of older Americans. As you know, retirees spend more resources on health care, housing, and energy costs than the general population. By adjusting the COLA formula to the CPI-E, your bill immediately helps Social Security recipients meet their daily needs. In addition, your legislation gradually phases out the earnings cap on wages. The current cap has fallen well below historical levels. It has become a tax loophole that could impact the long term financial stability of the Social Security Trust Fund. The Protecting and Preserving Social Security Act recognizes that inequity by phasing out the cap in order to strengthen the Trust Fund and provide increased benefits to those who contribute more.

We thank you for introducing this important legislation and look forward to working with you. Your leadership in this effort demonstrates your commitment to older Americans.
