Methodology: This poll was conducted November 9-13, 2014. It was authored by pollste collection by New Wave Media. Six hundred Israelis over age 18 were surveyed, 500 of the Arabs. The data was collected through a combination of internet and telephone interview interviewed in Hebrew and Arab respondents in Arabic. The margin of error was +/-4%.
